Our thanks go to all those who helped make the Supper held last Saturday a success. 9th October.

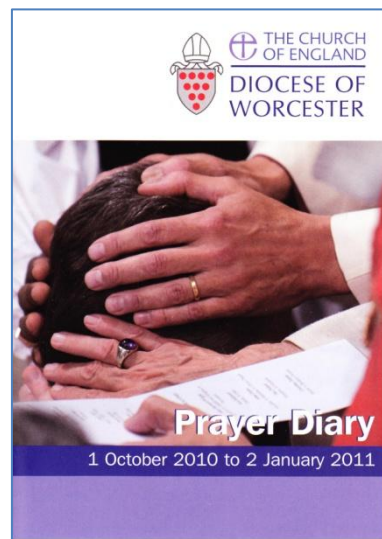
We made a presentation to Ann Fletcher in recognition for her service to the church over many years.
